## Introduction

This registration package contains all registration documents and information on costs for the two international WAKO CHAMPIONSHIPS. Please review the document and take note of important tasks and dates.

## Trip Logistics

The following are tasks to be completed as soon as possible.

Passport - All team members must travel on a Canadian Passport that is valid for 6 months after the return to Canada.

If your passport has expired, or you are not in possession of a Canadian passport, contact your passport office and make arrangements to apply for one immediately.

WAKO Status - All athletes must be registered competitive members with WAKO Canada for the 2018 year. Each competitor must bring their WAKO passport and 2018 Medicals to the Championship.

Travel - All travel arrangements will be made by WAKO Canada. Flights will be departing from Pearson International Airport or Dorval Airport.

**No personal flight bookings will be permitted.**

All travel detail will be provided by July. This will include the flight itinerary, and accommodation details.

*Private coaches, family members, tourists must also book through WAKO if they wish to stay at the tournament hotel and have access to ground transportation organized by WAKO.*

Insurance - All Canadian athletes will have insurance coverage through WAKO Canada. This is medical and liability coverage.

## The Canadian Team

Participating in the WAKO World Championships is a tremendous experience and opportunity for every individual athlete and supporter. The WAKO Worlds is the most competitive International Tournament in the world. Being a member of the Canadian Team is an honor. Over the years, it has been a priority of WAKO CANADA to foster and encourage strong team spirit and unity.

This priority grew from watching other National Teams, especially those successful European countries. The athletes from those teams were always seen together at International Events – they ate together, toured together, warmed-up together and always supported each other during individual matches.

It was no wonder that these countries produced the top finishers and were respected by all other teams and athletes.

In recent years, team spirit, respectful conduct – as well as a high standard of athletic performance - have become trademarks of Canadian Kickboxing teams. All of these traditions are priorities for all the coaches of the Canadian Team.

At the second training camp each athlete will receive an '**Athlete Code of Conduct**' that has been used by the National Team in recent years. The Code outlines expectations and specific guidelines.

All athletes are expected to sign this document indicating their understanding and agreement of the conditions outlined. Any athlete who fails to adhere to the Code can be withdrawn from the competition.

The Code is to emphasize our commitment to the highest level of dignity and respectful behavior by all Canadian athletes, and to foster team camaraderie that goes unequaled at the World Championships. Further the Code reflects regulations imposed by the WAKO International Federation.

Additional information on the World Championships will be sent to all delegation members in June. If you ever require specific information please feel free to contact our office at any time.

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## Training Camps

For many years we have run training camps to prepare athletes for the World Championships, as well as for other domestic and international competitions. It comes as no surprise that the most accomplished competitors have had the most consistent attendance at these camps.

There are camps scheduled throughout the coming months for all team members. Some camps will be specific for a sport discipline, while others are based on the province. **Attendance at all camps is mandatory.** If you are unable to attend due to an emergency or an unavoidable conflict, please contact the WAKO CANADA office as soon as possible or after the missed camp.

For the 2018 Canadian team, the training camps will reflect the training guidelines and suggestions provided.

Fitness testing will also be provided at each training camp. Athletes are expected to show improved scores at each camp. The coaching staff will work with each athlete in addressing challenges in the testing results.

### The dates for the ring sport training camps are below:

- Regional Camps - Dates to be set for each region Quebec/Alberta/Eastern Canada
- National Camp - August 25-26 (Burlington, ON)

The National Camp will be held at the WAKO Canada Headquarters. There will be a \$150 fee for the National camp. This fee goes to covering the cost of the WAKO National Team Fee as well as WAKO CANADA Administration costs.

Please come to the camp with the following equipment: sparring gear (headgear, boxing gloves, feet/shin guards, mouth guard, and supporter).

I, the undersigned fully understand WAKO Code of Conduct and agree to adhere to the expectations outlined in these documents. I, the undersigned fully understand that failure to adhere to any item in these lists will result in either or all of the following: my dismissal from the team, elimination from the competition.

I, the undersigned fully understand that in consideration of membership and permission to participate in amateur kickboxing and/or sport karate granted me or my son/daughter/ward by the Council of Amateur Sport Kickboxing Inc. (herein referred to as WAKO-Canada), I hereby release and discharge WAKO-Canada, its affiliated bodies, clubs, coaches, agents, and employees from all claims, actions, judgments and executions which the undersigned's heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns may have, or claim to have, for all personal injuries, known or unknown, and injuries to property, real or personal, caused by, or arising out of, the participation in the sports activity of amateur kickboxing and/or sport karate.

I, the undersigned fully understand that the WAKO World Championships event is an open competition and there is no guarantee as to the numbers of competitors that will be enrolled in any division. The officers of WAKO-Canada reserve the right to move competitors into other divisions so that they have an opportunity to compete. Each athlete has the right to not compete in the division they have been moved into – but therefore assumes the responsibility for non-participation in this event.

I, the undersigned fully understand that the officers of WAKO-Canada have made all reasonable efforts to ensure the safety and comfort of all travelers and competitors. However, I, the undersigned fully understand that traveling has inherent risks involved, including, but not limited to injury, sickness, and death due to, but not limited to, exposure to infectious diseases, change in climate, turbulent weather conditions, transportation accidents, as well as unexpected domestic crime. I am fully aware of the nature of these risks, but waive rights, claims, cause of action, etc., and heretofore, and do hereby assume all risks – both known and unexpected.

# WAKO Canada Code of Conduct and Ethics

The WAKO-Canada is committed to the highest standards of athletics, competitive ability as well as personal character development. As such it is expected that all members of the Canadian delegation will maintain a dignified and honorable presence at all times when representing Canada. In addition, WAKO-Canada is also committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity. All team members have a responsibility to:

- Abide by WAKO Canada's Code of Conduct and Ethics.
- Refrain from any illegal behavior during the entire duration of travel.
- Athletes will not consume alcohol and/or illegal drugs at any time from the flight to the Championship to the end of the Championship. This applies to all athletes regardless of age.
- Adhere to the procedures, and expectations established by the head of the delegation.
- Consistently demonstrate the spirit of sportsmanship, leadership and ethical conduct.
- Focus comments or criticisms appropriately and avoid public criticism of athletes, other coaches, officials, organizers, or competitors.
- Refrain from any behavior that constitutes sexual harassment, where it is defined as unwelcome sexual advances or conduct of a sexual nature. This includes behavior that creates an intimidating, hostile or offensive environment.
- Demonstrate respect of individuals regardless of gender, ethnic origin, age, religion, beliefs, or economic status.
- Abstain from the use of any performance-enhancing drugs or methods.
- Respect the hotel facilities and any location visited by the delegation.

All athletes are also expected to support all members of the team during training session and the competition. All athletes are will be in their room by the 11:00pm curfew, but may be changed at the coach's discretion.
