We are excited to announce the **14th Annual Provincial Kickboxing Championships** - the largest running Kickboxing Tournament in Canada! The WAKO Board is also excited to again announce that the location will again be at the beautiful Canadian Japanese Cultural Center in Toronto.

The tournament will again feature all Kickboxing Disciplines – K1, Low Kick and Full Contact with divisions for Junior, Intermediate and Senior athletes in the two separate experience classifications (novice and open). In addition, there will be Kick Light and Light Contact divisions for Cadets, Juniors, Intermediates, Senior and Veteran participants as well.

Top Female Senior Athlete - Top Male Senior Athlete - Top Intermediate Athlete - Top Junior Athlete

Only clubs registered for 2018 or 2019 with WAKO Canada can register athletes to participate in this championship.

All athletes must have a current WAKO Canada Passport and 2018 or 2019 Sticker Code (for ring sport) BEFORE entering them into the Provincials. If athletes enter the tournament but are not registered the discounted fees will not be accepted.

All athletes (Junior, Intermediate, Senior and Veteran medalist) qualify for seeding at the 2019 WAKO National Championship in February 2019.

To register for the tournament, use the enclosed WAKO registration forms. There is a separate form for each category, Junior, Intermediate, Senior Ring Sports, and Kick-Light.
