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Introduction

This registration package contains documentation for the 2024 WAKO WORLD JUNIOR / CADET CHAMPIONSHIPS. Please note any important tasks and dates below.

Trip Logistics

Passport - All team members must travel on a Canadian Passport that is valid for 3 months after the return to Canada. If your passport has expired, or you are not in possession of a Canadian passport, contact your passport office and make arrangements to apply for one immediately.

Membership - All athletes must be a registered competitive member with WAKO Canada for the 2024 year. WAKO IF Medicals/Waivers will be provided to all team members at the May training camp.

Travel - All travel arrangements will be made by WAKO Canada through the WAKO IF Office. Flights and accommodations are all centrally booked by our office. Flights will be departing from Toronto, Quebec or Montreal.

No personal flight or hotel bookings are permitted.

All flight costs will be provided by May 1st as our travel agent is working to secure the cheapest group rates.

One parent/guardian must travel/stay with the athlete in the same accommodations as part of the Canadian Delegation.

WAKO Canada is booking a group flight for our delegation which tend to be at a slightly higher fare than booking independently. The accommodation cost is also a group cost that includes all meals, tournament registration/spectator fees and in country transport.

Private coaches, athletes, and the one required parent/guardian traveling with the athlete must also book through WAKO.

Please note - Other family members can also book through WAKO Canada if they want to be part of the Canadian Delegation and wish to stay at the tournament hotel and have access to ground transportation organized by WAKO. Independent booking will not have access to Canadian delegation passes. Delegation bookings are not transferable to other individuals. WAKO Canada strongly advises against independent booking.

Insurance - All Canadian athletes will have insurance coverage through WAKO Canada. This is for liability coverage only. Athletes, parent/guardians and private coaches will be required to provide evidence of medical traveler's insurance.

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The Canadian Team

Participating in the WAKO World Championships is a tremendous experience and opportunity for every athlete, coach, parent and supporter. The WAKO Worlds is the most competitive international tournament in the world. It is a priority of WAKO CANADA to foster and encourage strong team spirit and our policies reflect this priority for our national team.

There are three requirements for all athletes of the 2024 National Team:

- 1. Canadian Nationals (April)** - Kick Light and all Ring Sport Disciplines
(A camp will be set up for all Point Sparring and Forms/Weapons competitors)
- 2. National Team Training Camp – May 11-12** * registration on the website
- 3. Provincial Training Camp** – (held across Canada) * dates to be determined

Attached is the '**Code of Conduct**' that is a requirement for all athletes and national team and private coaches on our National Team. The Code outlines expectations and guidelines.

All Canadian delegation members are expected to submit this document indicating their understanding and agreement of the conditions outlined. Any participant who fails to adhere to the Code can be withdrawn from the competition.

The Code is to emphasize our commitment to the highest level of dignity and respectful behavior by all Canadian delegate members, and to foster team camaraderie that goes unequaled at the World Championships. The Code reflects regulations imposed by the WAKO International Federation.

Training Camps

For many years we have run training camps to prepare athletes for the World Championships, as well as for other domestic and international competitions. It comes as no surprise that the most accomplished competitors have had the most consistent attendance at these camps.

There is one national team camp scheduled on May 11-12. **Attendance at the camp is mandatory.** Any private coach attending the World Championship is required to attend the NT camp.

The National Training Camp will be held at the WAKO Canada Headquarters. The camp fee goes to covering the cost of our international WAKO country fee and the cost of the national team coaches and leadership team that will accompany, support and coach all athletes.

Additional provincial camps will be held across Canada and details will be provided shortly.

Athletes will receive a sponsored team Track Suit and one competition uniform. Athletes participating in more than one discipline may be required to purchase an additional uniform.

DUE TO THE TOURIST SEASON WAKO HUNGARY IS REQUIRING ALL PARTICIPANTS TO BOOK THE HOTEL PACKAGE BY THE FEBRUARY DEADLINE. IF REGISTRATIONS COME IN AFTER THIS DATE, THEY WILL BE SUBJECT TO A HIGHER COST, PLEASE NOTE THAT WAKO HAS STRICT DEADLINES AND DELAYS CANNOT BE ACCOMMODATED.

Additional Information will be provided in the coming weeks along with schedules, equipment details, roles and responsibilities, additional medical requirements, and Canadian Delegation Requirements.

*All Private Coaches and spectators travelling with athletes must register with WAKO Canada to be part of our Canadian delegation. Failure to register with WAKO Canada will result in removal from the competition venue and host hotel.

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WAKO CANADA Delegation Waiver (Athletes, Coaches, Officials, Tourists)

I, the undersigned fully understand WAKO Code of Conduct and agree to adhere to the expectations outlined in these documents. I, the undersigned fully understand that failure to adhere to any item in these lists will result in either or all of the following: my dismissal from the team, elimination from the competition, suspension from future WAKO activities, immediate return to the airport prior to the return date.

I, the undersigned fully understand that in consideration of membership and permission to participate in amateur kickboxing granted me or my son/daughter/ward by WAKO-Canada, I hereby release and discharge WAKO-Canada, its affiliated bodies, clubs, coaches, agents, and employees from all claims, actions, judgments and executions which the undersigned's heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns may have, or claim to have, for all personal injuries, known or unknown, and injuries to property, real or personal, caused by, or arising out of, the participation in any of the sport disciplines of amateur kickboxing.

I, the undersigned fully understand that the WAKO World Championships event is an open competition and there is no guarantee as to the numbers of competitors that will be enrolled in any division. The officers of WAKO-Canada reserve the right to move competitors into other divisions so that they have an opportunity to compete. Each athlete has the right to not compete in the division they have been moved into – but therefore assumes the responsibility for non-participation in this event.

I, the undersigned fully understand that the officers of WAKO-Canada have made all reasonable efforts to ensure the safety and comfort of all travelers and competitors. However, I, the undersigned fully understand that traveling has inherent risks involved, including, but not limited to injury, sickness, and death due to, but not limited to, exposure to infectious diseases, change in climate, turbulent weather conditions, transportation accidents, as well as unexpected domestic crime. I am fully aware of the nature of these risks, but waive rights, claims, cause of action, etc., and heretofore, and do hereby assume all risks – both known and unexpected.

I, the undersigned fully understand that all payments (both deposit and full payment) are completely non-refundable if I have to withdraw from the competition for any personal reason including but not limited to illness, injury or family emergency. Should the event be cancelled for any reason beyond the control of the organizers and/or WAKO-Canada, all attempts will be made to secure refunds for all travelers, however there is no guarantee for a full or partial refund. I the undersigned, have read this Release/Waiver and understand all its terms and conditions, I execute it voluntarily and with full knowledge of its significances.

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WAKO Canada Code of Conduct and Ethics (Athletes, Coaches, Officials, Tourists)

The WAKO-Canada is committed to the highest standards of athletics, competitive ability as well as personal character development. As such it is expected that all members of the Canadian delegation will maintain a dignified and honorable presence at all times when representing Canada. In addition, WAKO-Canada is also committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity.

All Canadian Delegation members have a responsibility to:

- Abide by WAKO Canada's Code of Conduct and Ethics.
- Abide by all requirements of the WAKO International Federation, WADA and the organizing body of the Championship.
- Refrain from any illegal behavior during the entire duration of travel.
- Athletes will not consume alcohol and/or illegal drugs at any time from the flight to the Championship to the end of the Championship. This applies to all athletes regardless of age.
- Adhere to the procedures, and expectations established by the head of the delegation.
- Consistently demonstrate the spirit of sportsmanship, leadership and ethical conduct.
- Focus comments or criticisms appropriately and avoid public criticism of athletes, other coaches, officials, organizers, or competitors.
- Refrain from any behavior that constitutes sexual harassment, where it is defined as unwelcome sexual advances or conduct of a sexual nature. This includes behavior that creates an intimidating, hostile or offensive environment.
- Demonstrate respect of individuals regardless of gender, ethnic origin, age, religion, beliefs, or economic status.
- Athletes will abstain from the use of any performance-enhancing drugs or methods.
- Respect the hotel facilities and any location visited by the delegation.

All athletes are also expected to support all members of the team during training session and the competition. All athletes are will be in their room by the 11:00pm curfew, but may be changed at the coach's discretion.

I understand the above Code of Conduct and will abide by it during my tenure with the Canadian Delegation.
